We really enjoy having a chat together about our experiences in life and I love hearing about Malavika's day at school and what she is studying for A-levels.

Enrych is very good because it enables you do things that you probably wouldn't have done before. I must also add that the staff at Enrych are so committed to their jobs.

Malavika, now 18, became my volunteer when just 17. She has made such a huge difference to my life."
